# 2017 PHAA BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

- **1.** Vote as soon as you can after your voting papers arrive. If you wait too long, you might forget to vote. The PHAA is your Association, have your say in the future direction of the PHAA.
- 2. Mark a CROSS next to the name of each candidate you are voting for.
- **3.** One (1) Candidate for VIC and one (1) Candidate for Other/International Location to be elected. VOTE ONLY for the number of candidates to be elected from each State. Otherwise your vote will be invalid.
- **4.** Put your completed papers inside an envelope and put your membership number on the front of the envelope. Seal this envelope. Two ballot papers for a family or constituent membership may be lodged in the same envelope.
- **5.** Each person may vote and lodge one ballot paper for each membership they hold or in which they are a nominated person. Each nominated person in a constituent or family membership is entitled to vote (max two per membership).
- **6.** Put the sealed envelope inside a second envelope and mail this as soon as you can.
