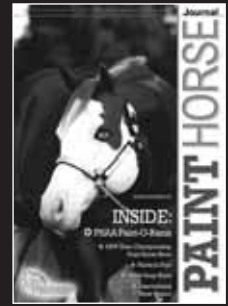

## Carolina Paint Horse Club's Spring Fling, April 14th, 2007

In April of this year I was lucky enough to be chosen for a one month Rotary Group Study Exchange to Western North Carolina in the United States of America. As a member of the Australian Paint Horse Association I was quick to contact the Carolina Paint Horse Club to see if there would be any Paint Horse Shows or Events happening whilst I was there.

Fortunately Connie Ellis, secretary of the Carolina Paint Horse Club, answered my email with great enthusiasm, inviting me to their Spring Fling in Arden, North Carolina. So on the 14th of April my team leader Ivan, another horse fanatic, and I wandered over to the North Carolina Agricultural Center for a day of Paint Horse magic.

We were met by Connie and her daughter Kami who, displaying true Southern Hospitality, spent the day showing us around and explaining the events to the 'folk from down under'. The Spring Fling is a two day show dedicated to Registered Paint Horses only. The Saturday events covered Halter, Showmanship, Hunter and Hacking Classes, Driving, Equitation, Equitation over fences, Jumping, Trail and Barrels. Sunday, which unfortunately we were not able to stay for, covered Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Cutting, Cow Horse and Reining.

Whilst the types of Paint Horses, attire of riders/handlers and style of riding were all similar to Australian Paint Shows, there were marked differences between the two countries.

Firstly, the number of competitors were high for a local show. Whilst Connie noted the numbers were well down due to the

weather (snow was predicted for later in the day) she said there were usually around twenty to thirty horses per class at these shows and more at four judge shows.

This was the second difference I noted, the judging system. Two judges (and often four judges) score every class independently of each other, with placings awarded per judge. For example, in Open Hunter Under Saddle, Judge A may award first place to rider 234, whilst Judge B may award first place to rider 121, resulting in two first places being awarded. When the horse and rider's names are called for placings, riders simply step their horse forward two paces from the line up and then step back into line. Riders accumulate points for certain places depending on the number of entrants in the class and these points are then counted towards national points.

Another difference was the height of the horses. Connie explained that in Carolina the trend is towards taller Paint Horses and it is rare to see a horse at the Paint Shows under 15hh. The top stallions standing at stud are around 17hh. Top show horses reach a decent price in Carolina too, with a former World Show champion gelding competing at the Spring Fling after being recently bought for \$US40,000.



There were a few unusual showing methods on display, with one handler in the led class flicking a cigarette lighter in front of her horse's nose to gain its attention in front of the judge, ultimately winning the event. It was also common for the trainers to line the perimeter of the pen calling out instructions

to their riders throughout the ridden events. With so many trainers yelling instructions I am sure it was hard for the riders to know what was aimed at them!

The Hunt Seat Equitation patterns were incredibly challenging at the Youth and Amateur level, with counter canter and flying lead changes standard maneuvers. Whilst they had similar class levels to our shows, the Carolina Club did not have Novice Horse classes, only Novice Rider. They also have a range of Equitation over fences and jumping classes, which were very well attended and appeared quite popular.

Overall it was a great day and a wonderful experience. A big thank you goes out to Connie and Kami Ellis for showing us the world of Carolina Paint Horses and to the Australian Paint Horse Association for providing me with lots of APHA goodies to present to the Carolina Paint Horse Club, which were the talking point of the show. I am sure there will be lots of trucks driving around North Carolina with PHAA stickers on their bumpers very soon.

If you are planning to travel overseas I encourage you to get on line and seek out your interstate and International Paint Horse Clubs and Associations – you never know, you may just make some wonderful new friends. ✪

## DIRECTORS REPORT - by Angela Newton

### - Breed Improvement -

Applications for 2008 Hall of Fame induction should have been submitted already, they will be due by December. Inductees will be presented during the National Show week and will coincide with our 35th Anniversary.

I am looking to feature the contributions of Australian bred stallions to the Association and will be running a series of articles of notable horses in the journal. If you have a "home grown" stallion that has progeny doing him proud in the show ring let me know and we'll sing his praises.

### - Non-traditional - Non competitive - Polo and Polocrosse

Competitors of these two disciplines are now rewarded for their contribution to the promotion of Paint horses. The new rule was ratified without contest from members and

takes effect on the 1st August 2007. Check out the Polo feature in this journal for an overview of the game.

**RULE 218** - Add new paragraph to end - Note - Polo and Polocrosse - Points will be awarded as follows - Horse In winning team - 3 points. Horse in runner-up team - provided three or more teams compete - 2 points.

### Team Penning

There was a member request for consideration of the same points rule for Team Penning. However, after much discussion it was concluded that they are not admissible as it is possible for a competitor to enter the same event 3 times in 3 different teams.

If you are out there competing or promoting your Paint horses in a non-traditional or non competitive way, we would love to hear from you.

### - Geldings - Futurity Incentives

The gelding incentive has been raised

to \$300 for the Weanling futurity. This makes it much more worthwhile to enter those geldings in the futurity than in the past. Nominations for this year's foals closed on the 1st August, but keep this in mind for next year's.

### Gelding Amnesty

There has been a change to the Gelding Amnesty rule, this is a procedural change and will impact the turn around time on approvals.

### Addition to Rule 102(f)

*"..Gelding Amnesty applications received by the PHAA which meet the above provisions, shall be advertised in the Paint Horse Journal and on the website. Objections to the approval of the application will be accepted up to 30 days following the publication of the Journal. The Board will consider the Gelding Amnesty Application including any objections lodged within the specified time, at the next scheduled Director's meeting."*



## AMATEUR OWNER REPORT - by Lee Wear

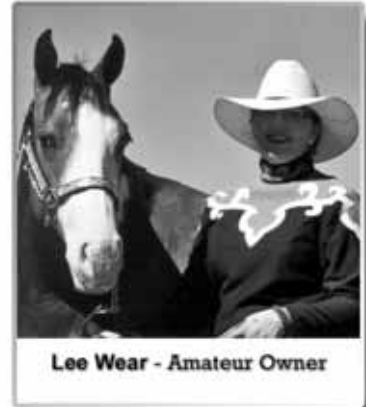
By the time this is published the foal raffle will have been drawn and RU Chase N Dreams should be with her new owners. I hope to see her out in the show ring with her new owners shortly.

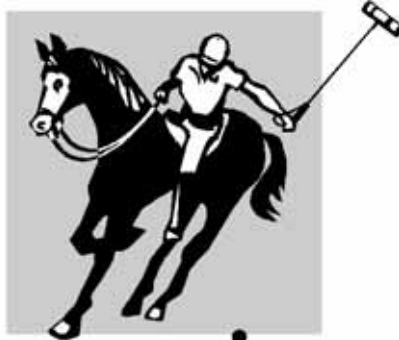

The Polo and Polocrosse industries are growing in popularity in Australia and are great potential markets for athletic Paint Horses. As an example, the Polocrosse World Cup competition was held in Warwick in April 2007, it was contested by 7 nations and attended by over 40,000 spectators. The event injected \$2.1M into the host town.

Whilst Thoroughbreds and Australian Stock Horses are more commonly used, any athletic horse around 15.2 hands that is able to stop and turn extremely fast, to accelerate quickly, to have stamina and to push and ride-off other horses is desired.

## An introduction to polo...

The game is played on horseback by two teams of three to four players equipped with long-handled mallets. Each team attempts to drive a small ball downfield and through the opponents' goal posts. Possibly the oldest team sport in recorded history, polo is thought to have ancient origins. The modern game is credited to a group of British officers stationed in India in 1862, who copied tribal horsemen



playing a form of polo. The most basic concept in the sport of polo is the line of the ball, a right of way established by the path of a travelling ball. When a player has the line of the ball on his right, they have the right of way. This can be taken away by moving the player off the line of the ball by making shoulder-to-shoulder contact. A player can:

- hook an opponent's mallet,
- push them off the line,
- bump them with their horse or steal the ball from them.

Standard polo fields are 150 yards wide by 300 yards long with 24 foot wide goal posts centred at each end.

Goal posts are mounted on stakes set in the ground so they will readily fall over if hit by a pony.

The polo mallet: shafts are made of tapered cane with heads of bamboo tree root. They are different lengths depending on the size of the pony.

The polo ball: made of white high impact plastic; 3 1/8" in diameter, 4 oz. in weight.

One umpire handles average games, but for important matches, two umpires are on the field with a referee in the stands. The umpires' primary concerns are right of way and the line of the ball.

- The line of the ball is an imaginary line that is formed each time the ball is struck.
- This line traces the ball's path and extends past the ball along that trajectory.
- The player who last struck the ball is considered to have right of way, and no other player may cross the line of the ball in front of that player. Riding alongside to block or hook is allowed, as long as the player with right of way is not impeded.

A timekeeper times the play and allows for time outs. The usual outdoor game consists of six 7 minute "chukkers" in polo language. Time out may be taken for a

foul, safety, injury, broken tack (bridle, saddle, helmet, etc.), broken or buried ball. There is no time out allowed to obtain a new mallet; to change from a tired to a fresh pony; or for a player unhorsed (but uninjured) unless the loose pony interferes with the game.

To start a polo match, the umpire faces the players which are paired off and bowls the ball in between their ponies. This same procedure is used to resume play after a time out is called or for a ball out of bounds over the sidelines. The ball is always put into play at the point where it left the playing field.

Players have ratings from B (or - 10) to 10 goals. This is a value of their ability as a player and provides a means of comparing one player with another. It does not mean they will score this many goals in a game, however. The goal rating of each team's players are totalled, subtracting the lesser team's rating from the greater and giving the difference to the weaker team establishes the handicap. In some championship matches, no handicap is allowed.

#### • Polo ponies

The term "polo pony" is a traditional phrase used to describe a horse of any size or breed that is used to play polo. In the early days of polo history the height of the mounts used for polo were restricted to pony size and thus the term "polo pony" developed. The average size of a polo pony used today is about 15-15.3 hands tall. Polo ponies can be of any size or breed. However, the majority of mounts in the upper levels of competition are

Thoroughbred, with some Quarter Horse or Argentine Criollo bloodlines mixed in."

Although they are not recognized as a distinct breed, polo ponies are truly unique horses that combine the traits of a number of breeds. Next to a player's skills, the polo pony is the most important factor in polo. And, many times, the pony is the single greatest determinant of the outcome of a match.

In the United States, Thoroughbred horses are usually bred with Quarter horses to produce polo ponies.

### • Polo Competition in Australia

Polo is played in 5 States in Australia: NSW, QLD, SA, VIC & WA. There are approximately 50 Clubs throughout Australia, each affiliated to their State Polo Association.

The Australian Polo Council (APC) is the governing body of polo in Australia. It is made up of Delegates representing each State Polo Association. Its objectives are to promote the playing and interest in polo; to co-ordinate international teams and matches; to set rules, policies and guidelines; and to supervise handicapping of all Australian players. ♣

This feedback and subsequent discussions with members by phone and email will greatly assist us in improving how we run the futurities. There were some fabulous suggestions along with some constructive criticism, all of which is helpful.**

I have as futurity portfolio holder been working on a spreadsheet, perusing rules from around the world and am in the process of putting together items for discussion at the Board Meeting for the entire Board to consider.

In addition to perusing futurities, rules and processes from around the world I have been making enquiries with regard to show programs and formula to ensure the most accurate and fair scoring system. At this stage it may be simply an Excel spreadsheet which is customised for our needs. I would be happy to hear from any members who have had dealings with show programs that can handle multiple judges for a final score and placings. There may well be a product out there that will cater to our needs.

Unfortunately we are not in a position to utilise palm technology for direct electronic entry of results from the arena, the cost was prohibitive and it did not eliminate the margin for error at the entry point.

The office procedure for handling futurities is also on the list for review with a view to lowering the margin for error. It is rather a hectic time for office staff and the more we can assist them the better it is for all concerned.

This is a process of continuous improvement, the opportunity for feedback and suggestions with regard to futurities is still there, so please do not hesitate to contact me.

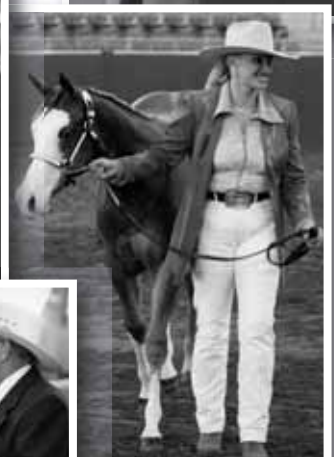

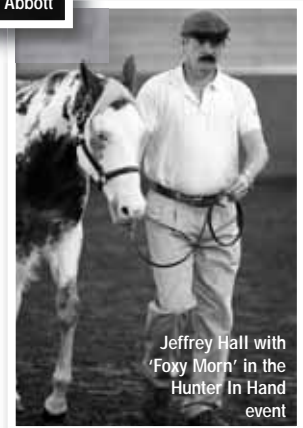

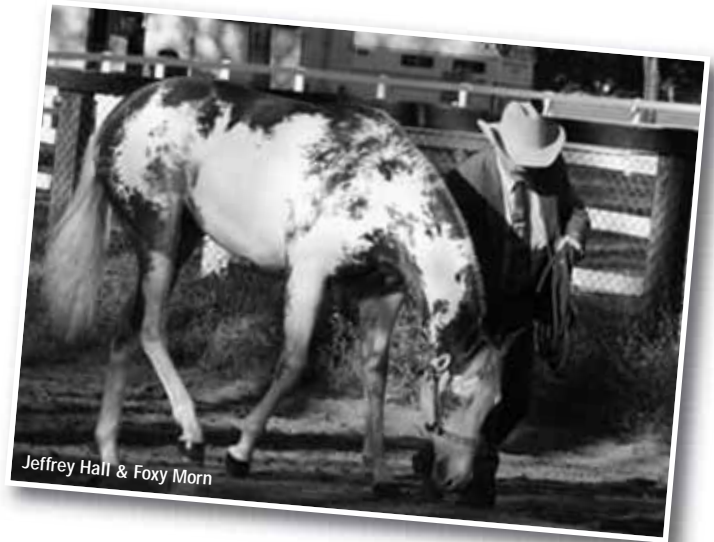


# PHAA PAINT-O-RAMA

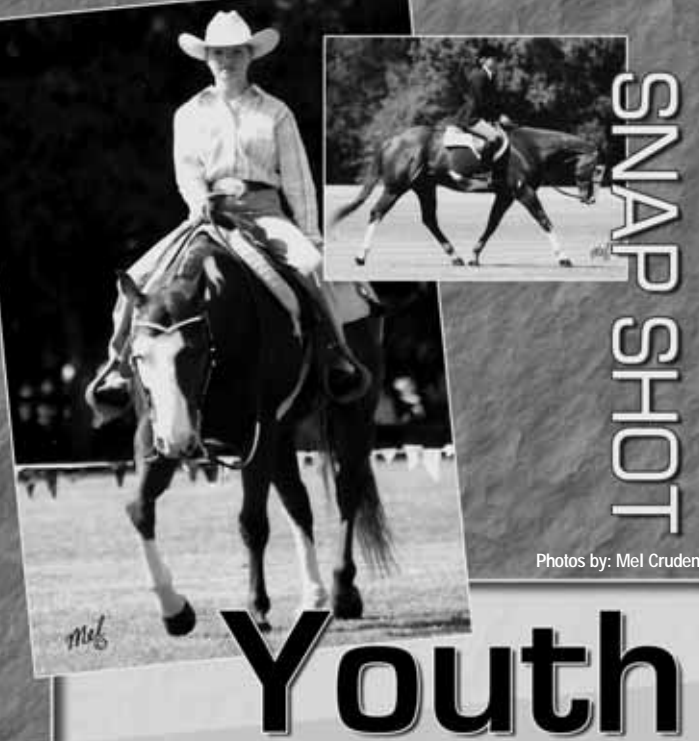

The requirement to advise the name of the judge will be relaxed to 14 days prior to each show date. Should there be any changes to the program a new approval fee will apply. Other approval requirements stand.

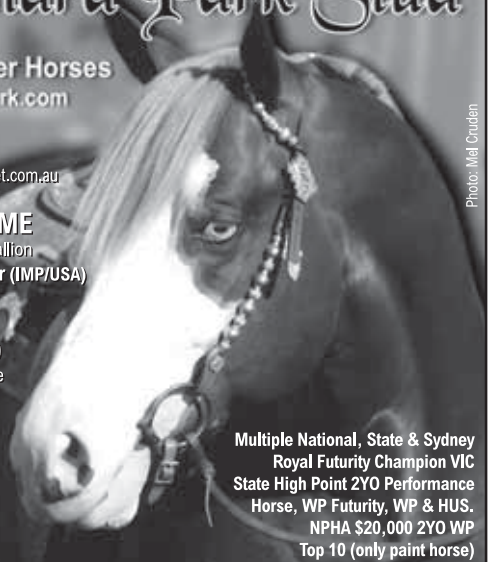
