At the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting the new Board meets together to elect the Executive and to appoint portfolios. I would like to thank the directors who had faith in me to elect me as President, I can assure you that I will strive to do the best possible job as your President. I welcome our new directors Vicki Hume of Tasmania and Amanda Sproules of Queensland and look forward to working together with you and the continuing Board members.

Now is the time to renew your Membership and your Amateur Owner card, both are due July 1st. Please don't overlook your renewals, you will miss out on the benefits that are available to members as well as missing copies of your Paint Horse Journal

Breeding Returns are due to be lodged and paid by the end of this month – June 30th. The fee per mare is a modest \$7.50 per mare, however if you are late the fee jumps to \$32.50 per mare.

The PHAA National Show is not far away now and I trust that we will see as many members and competitors braving the winter chills as would have made the annual pilgrimage to Dubbo at Easter. EI was of course the reason for a change of dates and with so many equine associations having to put their events on hold, getting a date for our National Show was always going to be difficult once the go ahead from EI was given. The decision had to be made to accept the August date or have no National Show for 2008, the obvious answer – hold the Show.

A FEW REMINDERS FOR THE NATIONAL SHOW:

• Travelling Horse Statements - all horses must be registered on a Travelling Horse Statement (THS) – available from the NSW Department of Primary Industries and able to be downloaded from their website http://www.dpi.nsw.gov.au/agriculture/I ivestock/horse/influenza . No THS - no entry onto the grounds, this is a NSW Government requirement that the PHAA must adhere to.

• APHA Gelding Plus - Do you have a gelding 4 years or older? APHA are again offering \$3000- in prize money under the APHA Gelding Plus program. Your gelding must be registered with APHA (regular or solid paint bred) See the separate notice in this issue or visit http://www.apha.com/geldingplus/

• Memberships - In order to compete in the National Show all riders / owners / competitors must be a financial member of the PHAA for the 2007/8 membership year. The same applies for any one with Amateur status wishing to compete in Amateur events at the show.

Have you looked at the PHAA website lately? A thank you to Director Sally McPhee for her work in setting up the "Marketplace" pages - members are now able to list their stallions at stud and horses for sale. Check the pages on the site for the requirements and list your horse.

Shortly after receiving this Journal the 2008 PHAA Youth Team will be leaving for the APHA World Show and Youth World Games. I am sure that all of our members will wish them the best of luck and will look

forward to reading about their adventures in future issues of the Paint Horse Journal. This year has been a tough year for fundraising for the youth, with almost no horse shows held during the period that the funds must be raised.

Each participant is required to raise a minimum of \$4500- in order to be able to attend. Several of the team members , and no doubt their families, have done an extraordinary effort - one youth raising almost \$10,000 alone. A job well done!

On a final note - if you hold a full or constituent don't forget to pay your renewal early to receive the reduced price.

Though even getting semen transported from green zones was extremely difficult at times, only to find that after all the paperwork was faxed back and forth the green zone had gone into lock down also.

> With the National Show in August looming ever closer and after all the hard work you have put into keeping

those coats through the winter, I hope that it is a rewarding experience for all who attend. We must however, never lose sight of why we spend the money we do, drag our horses from event to event, why we relish the highs and bear the lows and that is for the promotion and love of our breed and the comradeship of our friends and family.

New Zealand has some good bloodlines and has recently imported some further great stallions – Paint and Quarter Horse – not too mention the magnificent thoroughbred breeding and training establishments that our Australian trainers are rightfully envious of. New Zealand is a great country to breed and raise horses of any discipline.

For the last 13 years the Paint Horse Association of New Zealand (PHANZ) has held an annual National Championship Show, with numbers steadily increasing and quality leaping ahead. Studbook numbers and memberships are growing, with some members and horses also being a part of the PHAA and the APHA.

PHANZ Treasurer, Paula Berg, has been kept very busy organising the New Zealand Western Riding Federation Championship Show (judged by Australian Glen Wise) and also as one of the organisers of the New Zealand National Paint Horse Show.

Speaking on the Paint Nationals, Paula advises – "The judge, Mark McCarthy from the USA, was a lovely man. I have had awesome feedback from the competitors in regards to his judging and also his fantastic manner, he is very encouraging, especially to the younger ones and the newer riders." This year APHA offered support with a trophy buckle for High Point International Registered Horse and garlands for other International winners.

Paula tells me "These awards were absolutely awesome. Although we didn't have a huge amount of entries, which I think was due to the fact we didn't really get the time to promote the buckle, it had people buzzing and talking about that



awesome buckle. We had all of the information out and lots of people were coming and helping themselves, so fingers crossed they start thinking about that one for next time."

Easter Weekend saw The Paint Horse Association of New Zealand's 13th Annual National Show, held at the Waipa Equestrian Centre in Kihikihi. This year we were lucky enough to have two esteemed American Judged, Mr. Wayne Hipsley from Kentucky, judging our English events and Mr. Mark McCarthy from Colorado judging our Western Events.

This year was the introduction of International Halter and Performance events which were introduced to celebrate and acknowledge both the APHA and PHAA with their contribution to our ever growing bloodlines. Both a Halter and a Hi Point Performance Award were up for grabs this year, seeing 'RJ's Amazing Grace' (RJ Ransom x Just Amazing) owned and show by Elaine McIndoe take out Grand Champion International



Halter Horse and 'Imagine' (Loot's Image x Mandaluck Miss Morn Decked) shown by Jozette Hazeldine and owned by Paula Berg, take out the title of Hi Point International Performance Horse of Show. It is hopeful in the future that these events will continue to be held and entries will also continue to grow.

Overall numbers were consistent with last year, with slight changes in areas such as the Halter Futurities. This year saw more younger stock making their debut's at the Nationals. It was nice to see the younger horses as the highlight of the show. Also, the English halter and ridden events had the best support ever since the Association had been running a full English program. The Supreme Champion English Halter Horse of the Show was won by Prairie Ebony N Ice owned and shown by Sarah Savage who made PHANZ National Show history, to be the first person to travel from the South Island, to solely, compete at the PHANZ National Show. Sarah also had the pleasure of continuing on in the Western Performance events to take out the Hi Point Rookie title of the show, making her enormous trip up from the deep south, all that little bit more worthwhile!

\$3000 - (US) is on offer again at the National Show for APHA registered geldings – foreign appendix registered and full registered geldings qualify.

APHA will award \$2500 to the APHA regular registered gelding with the highest points in performance events at the PHAA National Show and \$500 in the Paint Bred division.

To be eligible you must register your gelding with APHA before the National Show - so get moving now! The gelding must be 4 years of age or older. Open, Amateur and Youth classes are considered in the calculations from the results of all performance events. Halter does not count towards this award.

• DUBBO WEATHER IN AUGUST:

In response to Equine Influenza restrictions the PHAA postponed the 2008 National Show to August 5th through to 10th August, after consideration of numerous factors.

With the average maximum temperature of 17.2 c and the average minimum temperature 3.5 c during the month of August the PHAA will be negotiating with Dubbo City Council to hold the event in the Ewan McGinness Arena (this is the main enclosed structure at Dubbo Showgrounds) with the consideration of several important factors.

• ANIMAL WELFARE:

With the potential of low temperatures both in the morning and at night where at times we may show our younger horses it makes sense where possible to provide as moderate temperature for these horses where possible and this could be done within this enclosed arena facility.

• SPECTATOR AND PARTICIPANT COMFORT:

Once again we conduct feature events early in the morning and from 6pm at night. Obviously if we want our spectator and participants to enjoy their experience we need to provide where possible a comfortable environment and the Ewan McGinnes structure has the potential to do so.

This year it will certainly be difficult to predict the number of participants at the National Show. Where possible horses will be stabled within the arena complex to provide comfortable conditions for horses and people moving from the stable area to the arena area. Lets hope the weather is kind to us and the usual PHAA spirit keeps us warm. Invitations are extended to all persons wishing to nominate a PHAA member or Regular Registered horse for the 2009 Hall of Fame. Nominations close 1st August 2008.

To be inducted into the PHAA Hall of Fame is to be the most distinguished honour that can be awarded to an individual. The selection criteria and the nomination process must therefore reflect the prestige of the award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The criteria for induction into the Hall of Fame are:

PEOPLE

- Any person considered for induction into the Hall Of Fame should have aided, promoted and/or worked voluntarily for the Paint Horse Association of Australia; and for the promotion of the Paint Horses at promotional stands, State of National Shows; for a period of not less than 15 years.
- 2. The Board of Directors of the Paint Horse Association of Australia can from time to time, when presented with sufficient verified evidence, allow for lassitude in the induction of members into the Hall of Fame (unexpected death, accident etc).

• HORSES

Anyone can nominate a horse that they believe is deserving of Hall of Fame Status. Evidence both written and photographic from newspaper/magazine clippings etc, must accompany any nomination

- The inductee into the PHAA Horse Hall of Fame must have been outstanding for a period of years as a sire, dam, competitor or must have brought exceptional visibility to the PHAA.
- 2. The inductee must be registered in the Regular Registry with the PHAA.
- Any foundation Paint Horse Association of Australia regular registered horse, who had an impact through their descendents are eligible for Hall of Fame status provided sufficient verified evidence is provided.
- 4. The inductee must be deceased.

NOMINATION PROCESS

If you wish to nominate a qualified candidate all applications are to made on the official nomination form. Supporting information must be provided on standard A4 paper. The inclusion of personal letters of recommendation from others is helpful but they must be individual letters i.e. not copies of the same letters signed by different people.

The PHAA will research the latest information regarding breeder, owner and horse records for each horse nominee and may add to the material. Please keep in mind that horses selected for induction will usually have name recognition and are well known to the membership.

• REVIEW PROCESS

Nominations are due each year by 1 August, to be considered by the Board of Directors (BOD) at a meeting prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM) held during the National Show Week. A limit of 2 members and 2 horses has been set for induction per year. Successful nominees will be announced at the AGM.

Nominees will automatically remain under consideration for three consecutive AGMs, if not selected.

If selected for the Hall of Fame the individual, or if a horse, the owner of the nominated horse, along with the nominator, will be notified prior to the AGM.

In addition to the normal nomination process, there are two other means by which an individual can be placed on the Hall of Fame ballot.

- A list of past individuals who were influential to the growth of the association will be drawn to ensure that older deserving individuals are not forgotten. The BOD will review the list each year and may select candidates to be placed on the ballot.
- Each year a list of individuals will be developed from categories of accomplishment and will be reviewed for inclusion on the ballot. Examples of these categories are:
 - Notable National Champions and multi Honour Roll High Point recipients.
 - Leading sires and dams of PHAA champions
 - All-time leading point earners

tme **History of the PHAA** INTHORSF

In 1972 Americans Lyman and Alaire Tenney, son Todd and daughter-in-law Peta-Anne decided that a breed of horse such as had been developed by the American Paint Horse Association ha a definite future in the Australian horse industry.

In America the Paint Horse had been developed as a "Quarter Horse with Colour". Correspondence with the APHA was started and in April 1973 the Paint Horse Association of Australia was formed.

At the first meeting held at Hornsby, N.S.W., it was voted by those present, Lyman & Alaire Tenney, Todd & Peta-Anne Tenney, Lorraine Grant, David Farquhar, Alan Whip and Christine Ruckwood to follow the American Paint Horse Association Constitution and Rules and Regulations as closely

Joeleo a Bay Tobiano stallion foaled in 1973 is by "Le-Van Joe" an own son of "Levan" AQHA leading sire of ROM race qualifiers, and out of a black Quarter Horse mare "Donna Blaze Bar". Bred by Eugene Hickey, Chandler Arizona and imported by Lyman & Alaire Tenney. Arriving shortly after C-Note's Playboy, Joeleo was barely 18 months old when he was placed second at his first showing – in a stallion class. This show was the only defeat Joeleo suffered in the show ring that year; he as possible – with minor changes to suit the Australian conditions and the later formation of our Association. The Success of the PHAA was instantaneous, and many people were applying to register horses even before registration applications were printed.

With Peta-Anne Tenney as Secretary/Treasurer, the PHAA began registering horses in June 1974 and by June 1975 well over two hundred horses were listed, with almost as many members.

won all his classes for the rest of the year to win National High Point Halter Stallion 1974-75.

In 1975 he moved to West Australia where his training progressed and he won National High Point Cutting Horses 1975-76 earning all of his points in Open and NCHA competition, a feat he repeated for 1976-77. In 1976 he became PHAA Champion #3. Prior to moving to WA Joeleo had the honour of winning the first Paint Horse Race in Australia – as a two year old.


Joeleo has ROM's in Halter, Trail, Western Pleasure, Cutting, Western Riding, Reining and Bridle Path Hack. In 1975-76 he was Reserve National High Point Horse in Trail, Western Riding and Sprint Racing. Then 1976-77 saw him emerge as National High Point Horse in Cutting and Reserve in Trail and Working Cowhorse.

In the 77-78 season he won National High Point Reining and Western Riding and Equal High Point Bridle Pat Hack and Sprint Racing. As if to prove that things get better with age, he went out in 78-79 to be Honor Roll Cutting; Working Cowhorse and Sprint Racehorse and earned a PHAA Superior Cutting Horse Award.

Joeleo was put to sleep in December 2002 after his second heart attack. He would have been 30 years old the following February.

History of the PHAA





With the PHAA barely one year old, Jack and Christine Ruckwood's imported stallion a sorrel overo foaled in 1968 stepped onto Australian soil in time to court a few mares at the end of the 1973-74 stud season.


National Champion Yearling at the 1969 National Show at Kansas City, Kansas, Playboy was bred by Junior Robertson and Jim Smoot and came from a long line of National Champions. His sire C-Note was a National Champion and APHA Champion. C-Note's Sire, Mr J Bar, holds five National Champion titles, two in Halter, one Roping, and two in Get of Sire. C-Note's dam, Pocohontas, won the National Produce of Dam in 1966. C-Note's Playboy's dam was Squaw Cat a daughter of Dinky Reed AQHA. And the cropout mare Cat.

C-Note's Playboy proved to be an outstanding Halter horse in his first Australian show season, winning many championships and attracting a lot of attention to the Paint Horse breed with his flashy sorrel overo coloring – previously unseen in Australia.

For the 1974, 75 and 76 seasons C-Note's Playboy stood at stud for his owners, breeding many mares including registered Paints and Thoroughbreds. In 1977 the Ruckwoods leased C-Note's Playboy to Phil and Betty Carman and Betty commenced training the stallion for performance events. Now a nine year old, the imported horse put his mind to the job and in a short time was winning consistently in Bridle Path Hack, Western Pleasure, and Western Riding – and at the same time continuing his Halter success.

Grand Champion at the 1978 SPHC Victorian State Championships and Senior Champion at SEQPHC Qld State Championships were highlights of his time with the Carman's. Over a period of two years the Carman's showed him to his ROM Western Pleasure, ROM Halter and to PHAA Champion No. 7. He was also National High Point Halter Stallion and National High Point Western Pleasure Horse.

C-Notes Playboy was put to sleep on the 27th August 1987 at the age of 19.



Fire Trail was foaled in 1984, sired by AQHA Champion Vapour Trail and out of the first APHA imported mare Fireside Chat. Bred and owned all of his life by Kevin Mills, Fire Trail has two main homes, Crown Park Training Stables and Natan Paint Horse Stud.

Known as the quiet achiever Fire Trail commenced his show career at sim months and consistently placed in the winners circle. Proven to be one of the most versatile Australian bred stallions, Fire Trail won the first versatility stakes at the 1989 NSW State Show.

Through his illustrious career 1988-19990 Fire Trail earned numerous and various State and National Championships. Highlights of his career are

- PHAA Champion #77
- Superior Award Bridle Path Hack
- ROMS Halter, Western Pleasure, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Hack

Fire Trail's PHAA Honor Roll Awards consisted of

- 1987/88 1984 Colt (Halter)
- Hunter Hack
- Reserve Junior Bridle Path Hack
- 1988/89 Amateur Hunter Hack
- 1989/90 Junior Western Pleasure
- Amateur Hunter Hack
- 1990/91 Reserve Hunter Hack

After 5 years out of the show ring Fire Trail returned to the Nationals in 1995 and proved old boys can learn new tricks by receiving Reserve National Champion Working Cow Horse, National Champion Team Penning with Jim Hudson.

As well as being successful in the show ring, Fire Trail brought publicity to the PHAA by featuring on the first Paint Horse special on Burkes Backyard. Fire Trail was also used at the local TAFE for exhibitions/displays and also attended a parade at the Gosford thoroughbred race day in 1996 to promote the PHAA. Fire Trail died on the 3rd November, 2007 at the age of 23.

~ PHAA Hall of Fame inductee #1 ~ Peta-Anne Tenney

Peta-Anne was born in Sydney and was the oldest child of three. Her mother helped found the Hornsby Pony Club and Peta-Anne inherited her love of horses and often rode around the surrounding suburbs on her horse. At an early age, Peta was given a camera as a gift and then Peta began to combine her two great loves of horses and photography. Peta married Todd Tenney in 1971 and they have two boys. Along with her in-laws, Lyman and Alaire Tenney she founded the Paint Horse Association of Australia Ltd and was the secretary for the first three years and editor of the PHAA Journal. Peta-Anne lived and breathed the Paint Horse and along with her husband imported the stallion Le Van Dee Dee* 150.

Todd and Peta-Anne owned some of the top paint horse mares and were proud co-owners of the first two PHAA Champions Le Van Dee Dee and Joe Paint.

It was Peta-Anne that compiled the first PHAA studbook and she and Todd published the Australia's Western Horseman and the Stallion Yearbooks. Peta always made sure that Paints were

given good promotion and coverage in any of their own publications.

The Tenneys moved to Arizona USA in 1983 and while they no longer had horses, they still have Joe Paints awards in pride of place in their office.

A few years ago, she returned the silver coffee service, a gift from the PHAA to Todd and Peta as co-founders of the PHAA, to the office. It was a lovely gesture and one that proves that even today as far away as she is from Australia, she still holds the PHAA close to her heart.

~ ALAIRE TENNEY ~ 1923 - 2008

Erman Alaire (Browning) Tenney passed from this life on Saturday, May 17, 2008, at the age of 84. She and her adoring husband, Lyman, were residents of the Arizona Pioneer Home.

Born on October 13, 1923, to James Ernest and Erman Grace 'Polly' (Warren) Browning, Alaire graduated from Willcox High School in 1941. She met Lyman Tenney at Prescott during Frontier Days that same year and they were married on June 29, 1942 – a union that lasted 65 years. Their life together was a series of wonderful experiences with never a dull moment and they were seldom seen apart.

Alaire was a rancher's wife, raising her children Jim, Todd, and adopted son Cody teaching the "three R's" – riding, roping and ranching.

In 1957 she was named 'Mrs. Prescott' in the Mrs. USA Contest and placed third in the Mrs. Arizona contest! Alaire was an active member of Willcox Cowbelles and Yavapai Cowbelles, served as president of Prescott's Junior Monday Club and was a member of the Arizona Alpha Chapter of Lambda Chi Omega Sorority. She was a member of two horseback quadrille teams – the Barbara Worth Brigadettes of Prescott and the Galloping Gossips of Brawley, CA. She played fast pitch softball until she was 37 – and only quit then because of a bad horse wreck. She loved to watch her grandkids rope, run barrels and play ball, and enjoyed having them on the ranch. In 1966, Alaire became a pioneer in the vast Australian Outback, where she rode beside her husband to

'muster' thousands of wild cattle and domesticate wild water buffalo. When they left the Outback Alaire was an integral part of the Tenney team that educated Australians in roping and western style horsemanship – she was loved by all.

Alaire was preceded in death by her parents, J. E. & 'Polly' Browning, and her brother, Ernest Alvin Browning. She leaves behind her loving husband Lyman, her sons James Lyman (Marion) Tenney and Tommy Todd (Peta-Anne) Tenney, adopted son Cody Darrell (Sharon) Browning, grandchildren Jean Alaire (Tony) Albright, Cindy Tenney Lee, Tammy Tenney (Colby) Paquette, Charles Lyman (Mary)

Tenney, Jacob Lyman T. (Renae) Tenney, Cotton Logan T. Tenney, Cathy Noelette Hooker and Jeanette Kay Carslile and thirteen great grandchildren, Michael, Ashley, Rose, Rio,

Chaz, Tyler, Sienna, Jesse, Arianna, Myla, Lane, Stephanie and Christina.

In addition to the Gelding Amnesty procedures published in the February/March08 Paint Horse Journal:

As part of the gelding amnesty process and in order to establish the authenticity for the proposed, it shall be advertised in the Paint Horse Journal and on the website. Objections to the approval of the application will be accepted up to 30 days following the publication of the Paint Horse Journal. The Board will consider the Gelding Amnesty Application including any objections lodged within the specified time, at the next scheduled Director's meeting.

When a gelding is found to be eligible as per Rule 102 (g) and accepted as mentioned above, parentage registration requirements are –

If the parentage cannot be validated by a breeding return, DNA verification must be completed.









2008 VPHA State Championship Show...


What does red, white and blue and the VPHA State Show have in common? Champions of course!



He was our Granddaughters first ride, she was 10 months old and the first horse she ever cantered on at the age of 7yrs.He is used occaionaly as a lesson horse to beginner riders. We use him to run horses in, Rope cattle off of and drag anything thats too big to carry.


