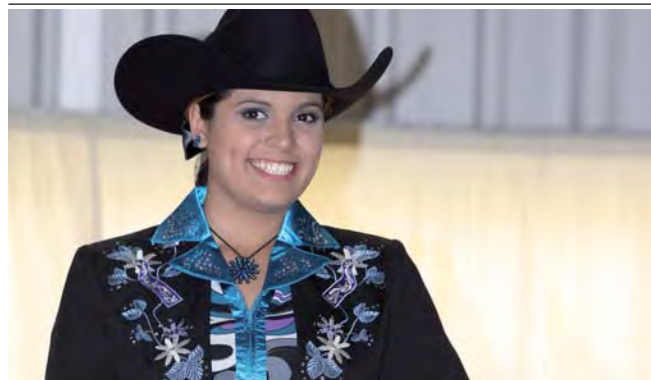

Don't scold the office team for trying to do our jobs. Do something that just may make a difference. The PHAA is after all YOUR Association.

One more thing. Not all suggested rule changes get approved by the Board of Director's or members voting at an AGM. There are many reasons why a rule doesn't get

changed which could include the rule change doesn't benefit the majority of members

or doesn't reflect what the Association stands for. The old adage "majority rules" certainly applies when it comes to setting rules and policies in any organization.

I would like to close this edition of the Office News on a personal note. I have worked for the PHAA for nearly 18 months now and I would like to thank the people who encouraged me to come on board or who supported my application and took a chance on me. # 2009 APHA Fall World Championship Show

The weather was superb - clear, fine and 75 Fahrenheit or 24 degrees celsius and nowhere near as warm as my previous trip in July of 2005 to Fort Worth, Texas for the World Show. I had four days of watching beautiful horses compete, socialising with great friends and eating some amazing food. No trip to the World Show is complete without at least one cinnamon roll for breakfast and I have to mention that I have now discovered Brazilian BBQ – YUMMMM.

The Aussie contingent has done us proud again with Craig Dengate and Karen Lonski's mare "An Intense Desire" taking out third overall at the World in the Amateur 2-Year-Old Mares. Led by Craig, in a very tough class, the gorgeous mare by "Intensely Tough" out of "River of Desire" showed superbly. In the open class "2-Year-Old Mares", with professional trainers holding the shanks, she again did extremely well taking out a top ten placing in the World.

Notably, the PHAA's worker bees, Jeffery and Lee Ann Hall were extremely

active in the show pens stewarding for the Judges. Lee Ann pencilled in the John Justin Arena for the ridden events and Jeffery spent many a long day on his feet lining up halter horses in the Watt Arena.

Personally, my trip to Fort Worth was to support some friends who have been showing extremely successfully with the progeny of their stallion "Mighty Ambitious" (Mighty Awesome x Sheza Heart Broker). "Mighty" is owned by Cheryl Vasi and stands at Jeff & Kerri Richards' Painted Dreams Farm. To date 10% of this young stallion's progeny have earned World titles.

I was honoured to be included in the supporter's team photo for "Southern

Ambition" owned by Jeff & Kerri who took Reserve World Champion in both Amateur Solid Paint-Bred Mares all Ages and Solid Paint-Bred Yearling Mares. Cheryl's entry "Xtreme Ambition" a palomino overo colt owned in partnership with her mother Danielle Vasi-Koeberle was the undoubted crowd favourite when he took out World Champion in a huge class of Weanling Stallions.

Whilst in Fort Worth, I also took the opportunity to meet with the APHA's Executive Director Lex Smurthwaite and thanked him for his support of our 2010 National Show as he is helping to procure a judge whose costs will be funded by the APHA. Lex was extremely generous and has offered his support to any of the Australian APHA members including the PHAA.

# Apache's little splinter

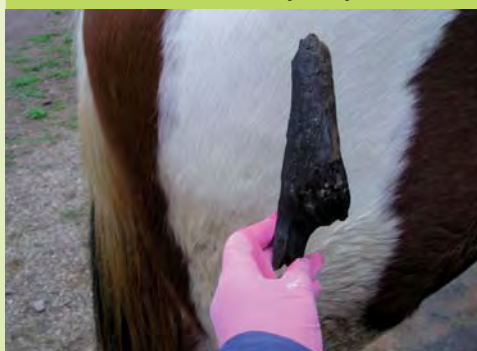

# HEAT STRESS

*A tragic story that needs to be told.*

## **4.30 am Thursday morning saw the arrival of Chilli ...**

He was extremely large and bent up. Mouse had done a great job delivering this little one without any assistance.

Chilli was extremely contracted in the front tendons ... being slightly overdue and sired by a 16.2hh stallion "Blue Shadow FX" out of QH mare "One Part Scotch". With the delivery of such a huge baby it is also thought Chilli was a slight dummy foal. Not as bright as one would expect. We phoned the vet at 11 am when he wasn't getting up as much as we would have liked and had not straightened up at all. As he had been up and drinking so we

were not too concerned about that. Upon arrival Bill (vet) gave Chilli an injection (oxytetracycline) to release his tendons as Bill advised that the issue was not heritable as such, but due to the size of the foal and the size of the mother that he was too cramped in the little space for too long. It is common for big foals born to small mares to be contracted. With another visit Bill was not completely happy with the progress of the injection, so another injection was given and this time we decided that we needed to splint his legs. We also applied corrective shoes to slowly push him back on his heels. So next we had our own little Forrest Gump boy ... he was so cute,

however again something was not right, so Bill did blood work as he wasn't clotting properly. With 500ml of plasma given and all was okay again. He was going really well and we were pleased with how his legs were coming. We decided to go away for the Sunday, we didn't know it was going to be one of the hottest days in Toogoolawah. We asked for a friend to come over throughout the day to make sure all was OK, though he had moved each time they came around, they didn't see him up or drinking ... We know now the downward spiral had started!!!

In our attempts to correct his legs, keep him safe and care for his every need, the loving care led to



## HEAT STRESS & TAKING PRECAUTIONS – Vet Bill Rowan (Brisbane Valley Vets) informs

Young foals main period of concern are for their first 4 weeks from birth, the period where they are relying on their mother to provide all of their nutritional requirements. Once they start to drink water and pick grass the degree of concern lowers as each week passes.

- Mothers that do not have a substantial udder are also cause for concern as the foals may not obtain their requirements as readily and will have to drink more often.
- Foals can dehydrate within 6 hours on hot days.

**The downward spiral** can begin very quickly. Foals may miss a drink because it is too hot and they are resting, when they do get up, they may not drink as much as they should because they are tired and want to go lay down again. Again, when it is time for the next drink this happens, soon instead of 3 drinks over an 1 hour period they only have 2 and the pattern continues to where they become so weak from dehydration that they can't manage to stand at all.

- In extreme hot weather 3-4 hourly checks on foals and 3-6 hourly checks on horses are recommended.
- Ensure that horses have plenty of shade.

Not necessarily boxes as this does limit the air flow, shelters with just a roof allows for ventilation and breeze. Portable panels can also be used as a covered yard by simply draping shade cloth over one end of the yard. Nothing beats a big shady tree.

- Mares should have access to plenty of fresh clean water. Supplying electrolyte or glucose in a separate container of water does not hurt on hot days also.

If you notice that your horse/foal is starting to show signs of dehydration or heat, being with hosing of the legs, the under line of the neck and between the back legs as these contain veins that act as a cooling system for the body.

If improvement is not achieved consult with your veterinarian.

Fluids may be required to assist in the recovery of your foal.

the proceeding events. On one of the hottest days in Toogoolawah, Chilli had his largest cooling points closed off. The main veins that run down a horses legs are one of the best cooling points of their body. This is why we hose down their legs first when they are hot ... Chilli died of heat stress that afternoon caused by the splints we had on his legs ... Our tragedy is not the only heat stress loss of the year. I do hope this article brings to the fore how quickly and easily young foals can become susceptible to heat stress.

**So please be vigilante

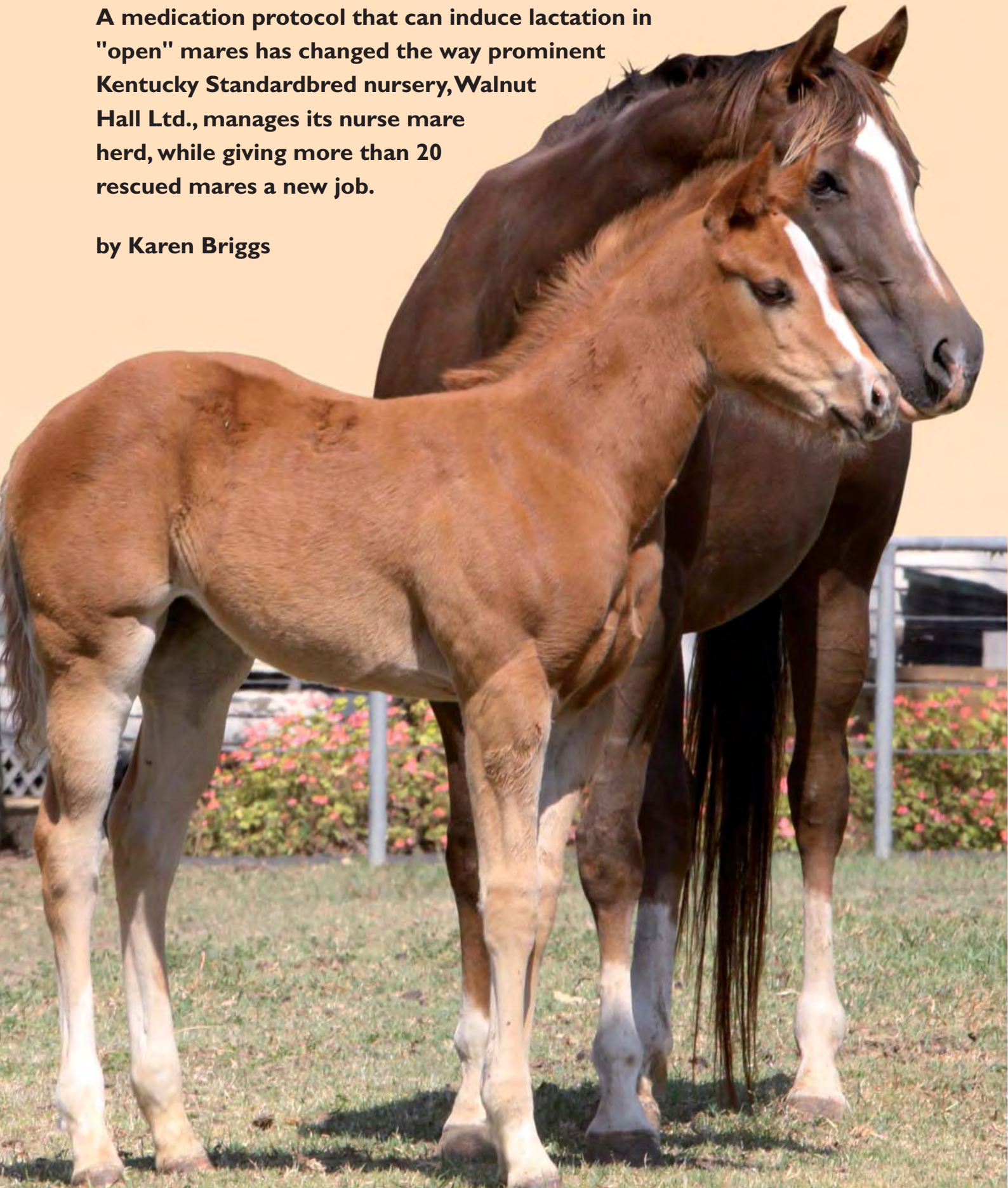




# Home Made Mothers

**A medication protocol that can induce lactation in "open" mares has changed the way prominent Kentucky Standardbred nursery, Walnut Hall Ltd., manages its nurse mare herd, while giving more than 20 rescued mares a new job.**

Walnut Hall's vet, Joe Lyman, DVM, based the technique on presentations by Peter Daels, DVM, PhD, and John Steiner DVM, Dipl.ACT. Using their methods, not only can unbred mares that have previously had at least one foal be persuaded with medication to produce milk, but the procedure also seems to stimulate maternal behavior, greatly simplifying the tricky process of getting a nurse mare to adopt an orphan foal. For an operation like Walnut Hall, which uses nurse mares routinely, it was a revolutionary idea.

"We breed to a lot of New York-based stallions," Lyman explained, "and New York state laws prohibit semen being shipped out of state. So we have to ship our mares to them, and that has usually meant leaving the foals behind with nurse mares, rather than putting them through the stress of shipping." Farm owners Alan Leavitt and his wife, Meg Jewett, have always been uncomfortable with the usual method of deliberately breeding mares, then removing their foals to make the dams available as nurse mares, he added, so this protocol presented a new opportunity. Shortly after his return from the Orlando meeting, Lyman began sourcing mares from adoption and rescue organizations, such as the New Vocations Racehorse Adoption Program in Ohio.

"We adopted 22 mares, mostly Standardbreds, with a few Thoroughbreds and a couple of Quarter Horses," he said. "The only real criterion was that they had raised foals previously and were good mothers. Maiden mares don't respond well to this protocol. "We even used a couple of our own mares that we'd retired from breeding due to reproductive problems, giving them a job again," he added.

Walnut Hall used a simplified drug protocol based on a once-a-day administration of an oral domperidone gel (a dopamine antagonist which increases milk production in mares and is also used to combat fescue toxicity). "If they're going to lactate, you'll know within three to four days, usually," Lyman said. "They'll start producing watery milk, and you'll see the bag start to fill. Most mares were in decent milk production within 10 days." Twenty of the 22 mares responded to the lactation protocol. When it came time to introduce

the foster foals, Walnut Hall administered a shot of oxytocin and prostaglandin to each mare, along with some mild sedation. This was followed by a vaginal/cervical massage, which Daels had found to be key to stimulating a maternal response.



"It was pretty neat," Lyman said. "Within a couple of minutes of doing the cervical massage, the mares would lower their heads and start nickering to the foal. It's a response called the Ferguson reflex. Sixteen of the 20 mares accepted their foals within half an hour, and the longest (time period) was a day. All 20 mares had accepted their foals within 24 hours. If you've dealt with nurse mares, you know that's an amazing success rate."

Since the induced lactation doesn't stimulate the production of colostrum (a sticky milk, high in protein and antibodies, secreted during the first 24 hours following birth), Walnut Hall found that foals aged seven to eight days were the most likely to thrive under the care of their nurse mares. "At weaning, you couldn't tell the difference. They were all big, robust kids, and their OCD (osteochondrosis dissecans) rates were similar to the foals raised by their own dams," said Lyman. "This is so much better than breeding nurse mares and ending up with unwanted foals," he added. "And the mares get a good deal out of it – they get a good life on the farm, a much better fate than they might otherwise have had."

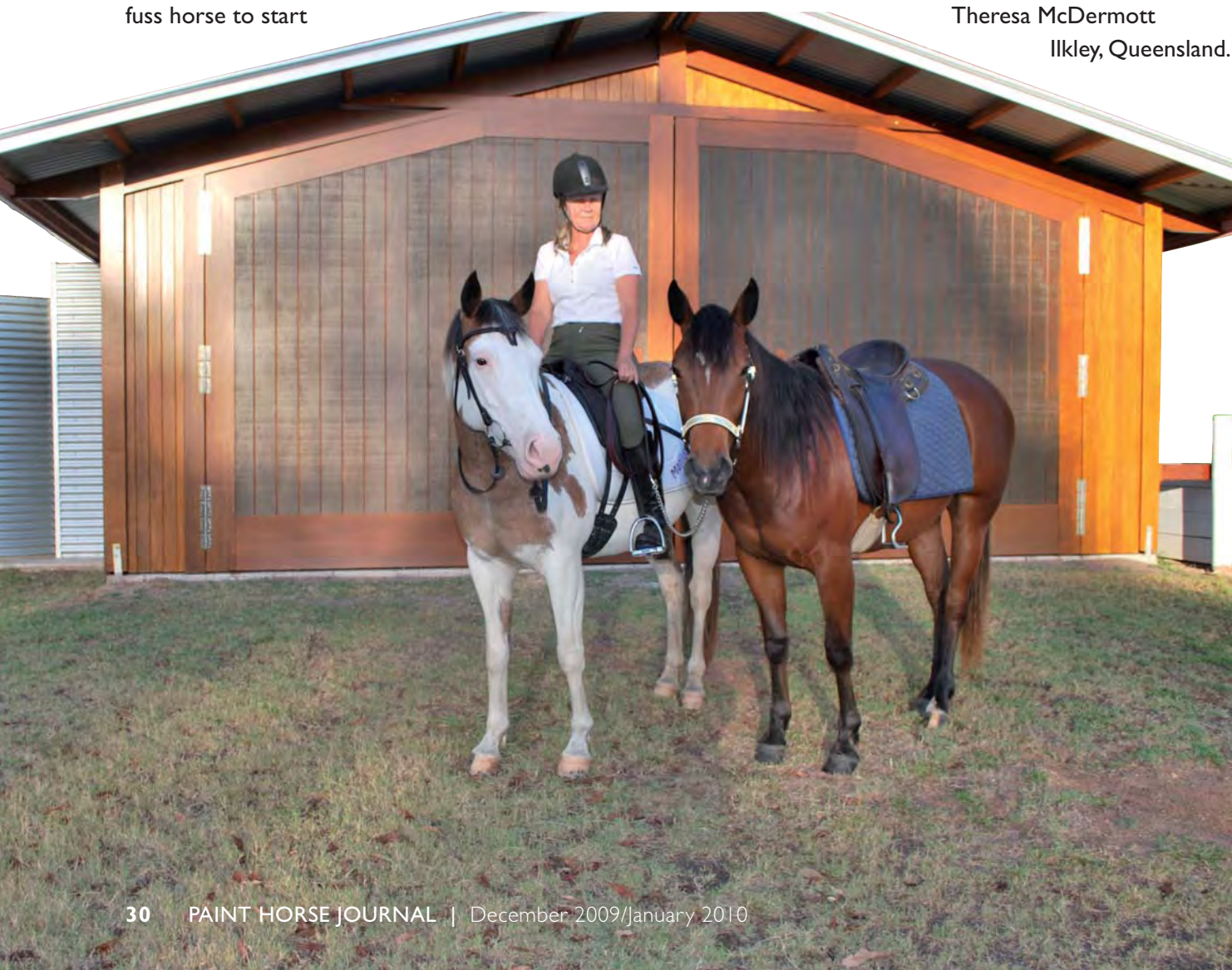
under saddle. Violet is always first to greet visitors for a cuddle and to have a chew on their shoelaces.

# From WHOA to GO!!

The break is over and the  
show season is about to  
get back into full swing.  
You're excited ... but  
are you ready?

Of course it's exciting! You can't wait to be back on the show circuit and in touch with all your Paint buddies again. It's a time to look forward to, getting back into competing, discussing and seeing new foals and upcoming youngsters or maybe to show off your own! You're even thinking about what events you're going to focus on. It's hard to curb your enthusiasm at the thought of the first show. The thrill of competition is just around the corner and you're totally prepared for the busy year ahead. Well – aren't you? Mmmm – maybe not totally prepared. If that sounds like you, make some changes this year. Read on, plan ahead and be completely organised!

### Funds

As exciting as it is, before you can decide on which shows you'll be attending during the coming year, you'll need to be realistic and make certain you're

the financial side of it. Just a snippet of information to keep in mind; agricultural show prizemoney is quite good and it would be beneficial for our Paint horses to make a return to these shows. So think about it. If you find yourself short of cash, plan on making a little extra income each week. The difference it'll make to your bank balance and show season will be amazing.

### National, State and Regional Shows

Mark these dates down on your planner and use different coloured highlighter pens to fill in the definites and the maybes. Write in the contact phone number for each show. Contact them early for show programs, entry conditions and pre-entry deadlines.

If you intend competing at the State or National shows, get your entries in as early as possible. Set goals for classes you intend on being really competi-

going to have the funds to cover the whole process. Showing is either part of your horse business or it's a hobby. Either way, money comes into it. The word 'budget', as horrible as it sounds, is something we all need to adopt in these times. So, before planning to go show, know the budget you'll be working with. Know where the money's going to come from and how much there'll need to be week to week. If you run a horse business, you'll have already done your sums and from here on in will just need to keep records of all your expenses and income. If showing is your hobby, sit down and work out how much you're going to need to feed your frenzy. It may help to open a separate bank account and use it specifically for your expenses and income (prizemoney, etc) from your horse showing. It's an easy way to keep track of

tive in at these shows, and then plan your showing strategy from the start to mentally and physically prepare yourself and your horse. Put some time into planning for these shows. They are major events on the calendar and mean you'll be away from home for more than a day or two. With this in mind, organise yourself early with regards to having your property and any 'left at home' animals cared for while you're gone.

### Vehicle & Float

There's nothing as bad as a breakdown on a busy highway when you're loaded up with horses and gear, not to mention your passengers. So before the show season starts up again be sure not to overlook these very important things. Take your vehicle and float along to your regular mechanic for a full engine and safety >>



» check. A wooden floor in your float, gooseneck or truck must regularly be checked for soundness, too. Drop into your local tyre dealer to have the same done on all the tyres. Bear in mind that taking these precautions won't always guarantee smooth travelling – anything can go wrong – so leave home prepared, just in case.

### Rule Books, Registration & Information

Depending on what shows you want to attend it's a must to have your PHAA association rulebook and HSAA rulebook as you will have to adhere to the rules and regulations each show is run under. Many shows are run under AQHA rules so it's a good idea to have knowledge of these rules too. There are likely to be rule changes each year, so make sure all have been noted or relevant pages replaced. Take your rulebooks to every show. Throughout the year regularly go through these rulebooks to keep rules fresh in your mind.

Set up a special show folder containing all relevant information regarding your membership, PHAA horse registration papers and Amateur Owner cards. Make certain these are current. Take this folder with you to each show. You never know when you may be asked to produce any of the information.

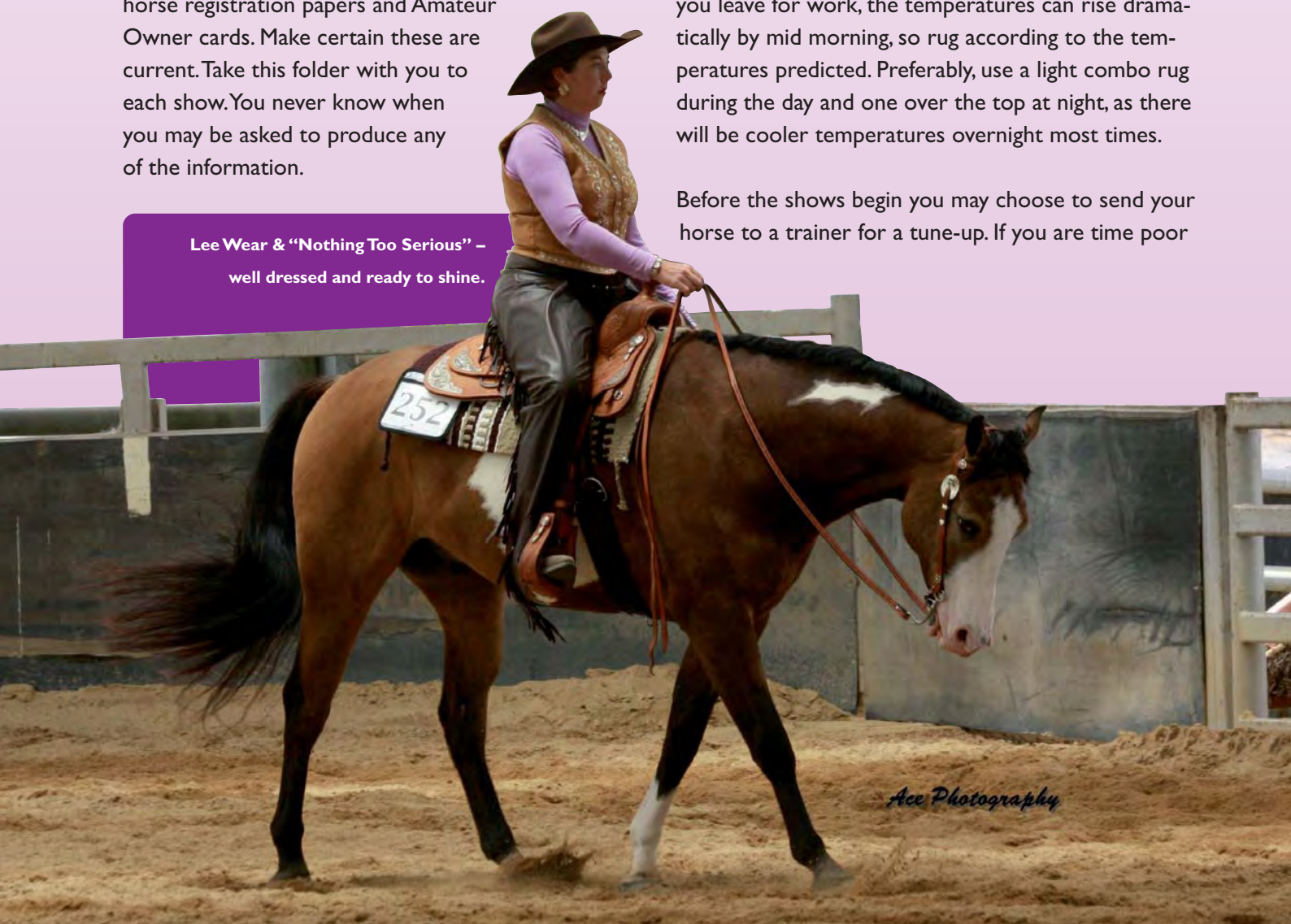

### Horse

Ideally, you'll have given your horse a holiday as well as yourself. Most of the time your horse will come back in from his break fresh in mind and body and ready to work. However, ease your horse back into the regular routine of rugging, feeding, exercise and training. Gradually increase the work and the feed and make sure the work suits the feed input. You don't want him overfed and under worked or vice-versa. Check with your veterinarian about any supplements he may need or use one you've been happy with. Be certain your horse is healthy and on his way back to being show fit. Is his vaccination and parasite control up to date?

If you haven't done so, have your horse's teeth checked. Many conditioning and showing troubles can be traced back to dental problems. His hooves should be regularly and neatly trimmed or shod and in a healthy condition. Regular and sensible rugging should be carried out to get his coat in top condition. These are the hottest few months of the year, so take care. In some parts of the country, while it can often be cool when you leave for work, the temperatures can rise dramatically by mid morning, so rug according to the temperatures predicted. Preferably, use a light combo rug during the day and one over the top at night, as there will be cooler temperatures overnight most times.

Before the shows begin you may choose to send your horse to a trainer for a tune-up. If you are time poor

this can be a great option. It'll take some pressure off, giving you some much-needed time to put into some of the other things you need to focus on for the coming show year. You may also wish to start the New Year off with some tune up lessons for both you and your horse. Whatever you decide to do, it all adds up to sensible preparation for horse and rider.

### **Tack**

Ideally you keep your tack and show gear correctly stored, clean and dry. Take out all your tack and check each item for wear and tear. Organise for any items to be repaired if they need it. Clean and condition the leather, polish silver and bag each one ready for travel. Check and, if necessary, clean all leg boots and training gear. Check your show pads for built-up dirt, grime, seeds and prickles. Wash them if they need it. When packing for shows be sure to pack a couple of extra bridles, reins, halters and bits.

### **Grooming Box**

Replace grooming tools or brushes that have gone past their use by date and check that any towels or grooming cloths you've used are washed or replaced. Re-stock your horse shampoo, conditioning and grooming products and fly repellent. Make sure to buy a white coat brightening product and some hoof black or clear gloss. Have your clippers been cleaned since the last time they were used? Remove the clipper blades and send them away to have them sharpened. Oil them and store them with the grooming box.

### **Show Clothes**

Check all of your show clothes. Do any have broken stitching, stains or missing buttons and studs? Have them mended or DIY. If you need to send anything to the dry cleaners, do so early. Check your chaps for any buckle, zipper or stitching problems. Check, clean and re-shape hats and store in a hatbox ready to pack. Clean and polish all silver, accessories such as show jewellery and all boots and spurs. If you need to order any clothes or accessories for any of the major shows, do so early so that you aren't disappointed.

### **Camping**

Are you set up to stay overnight at a show? Get yourself organised early. Make sure you have all the basics

for a comfortable overnight stay. Make a list of required camping items and use it every time.

Knowing that you're fully prepared for the year will now leave your mind free to concentrate on the job at hand. That is, showing and enjoying your Paint Horses.
