PHAA Office Updates - FEBRUARY/MARCH 2009

• A BIG HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ALL MEMBERS...

We know this is the February/March issue of the journal but the planning and the closing date for articles was the 1st January. So a big tip for anyone wanting to advertise or submit articles – you have under a month from the last journal you receive.

The PHAA Office hopes that 2009 has started in a better way for members than 2008 did with EI.

• 2009 NATIONAL SHOW - ENTRY FORMS...

The 2009 PHAA National Show program and entry forms are now available to download. Please note there are some minor changes to the program as published in the December/January of the Paint Horse Journal. A revised program is included with the entry and stabling forms.

• UPGRADING OF STALLIONS...

A reminder that stallions cannot commence breeding until DNA results have been received and the database has been updated. This rule was relaxed in 2007 due to EI but has now been reinstated.

• REGISTRATION PHOTOS...

Far too often the processing of registrations is held up by unclear or bad photos. Please use the following guidelines when submitting photos.

All applications for registration must be accompanied by four clear recent pictures which shows each side, front and rear. Pictures will be kept permanently on file with the registration applications. Good clear recent pictures are required, with the horse image in the photo being 75mm x 90mm or 3" x 3 1/2".

Pictures are to be taken of an unsaddled horse standing still, held with head in normal position as shown on a registration application. Show all four legs in each side picture and full frontal of face in front on picture. If horse has a mane, hold it away from the side being photographed so neck markings are visible. For light coloured horses (palominos, duns, greys, roans, etcetera), wet the horse thoroughly so that the dark skin pigment shows clearly the location and patterns of your horse's colour. This is best done on an overcast

day so the sun does not cause dazzle from the wet coat, as this makes the pattern hard to discern. Ensure that your horse is clean as sometimes dirt and stains can look like part of the colour pattern. Inadequate photographs will cause delay in the processing of papers as you will be asked to supply better pictures. Pictures should be clear so markings can be distinguished.

Additionally if you have a minimally marked horse it is recommended that you also supply photos with either a ruler or guide against the potentially qualifying area to help the office decide whether the horse requires inspection or not. This applies to both the qualifying white hair and pink skin.

• OUTDATED FORMS...

It is time to have a clean out!

When you send in an application form to the PHAA for membership, registration, lease or anything else, please ensure you use the latest forms which are available from this website or on request from the office.

Some members must have stores of old forms that are years old and which they keep using - when sent to the office with the wrong fee or insufficient information, this causes delays to processing and a whole lot more work for the office staff.

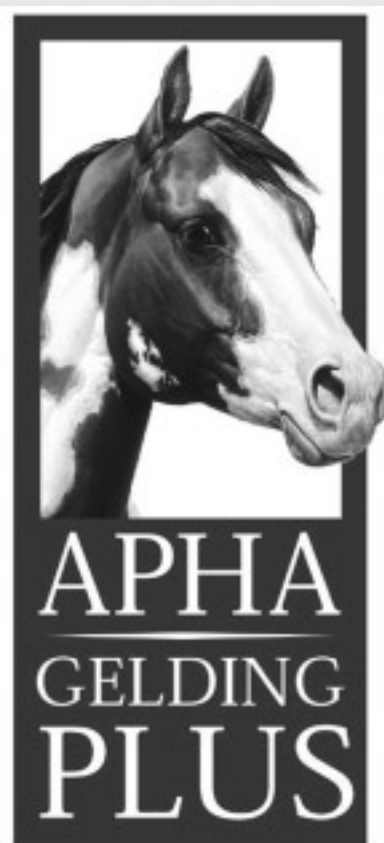

APHA TO AWARD US\$3000 AT 2009 NATIONAL SHOW

For the third year in succession, the American Paint Horse Association will recognise APHA registered Australian Paint Horses with financial rewards at our National Show. APHA have on offer \$3000 (US dollars, which at current exchange rates is over \$4000 Australian dollars).



APHA host a program known as GELDING PLUS. By being a part of this program you may be eligible to win some of the \$3000-. ALL PHAA registered geldings are able to be registered with the APHA, they do not need to be bred directly from APHA sires and dams.



Your gelding will fit into the APHA Foreign Appendix registry if he is not able to receive "full" APHA registration, both Appendix registered horses and full registered APHA horses can compete on equal footing for the prizes. In order to be eligible you best get your APHA registration away quickly so that your gelding is registered by our National Show.

There will be \$2500 awarded to the highest point Regular Registry Gelding and \$500 to the highest point Paint Bred gelding. Following is some information taken direct from APHA.

The Gelding Plus program promotes aged Paint geldings 4 years old and older by paying out \$42,000 at select APHA approved events. With automatic enrollment for every APHA gelding who is officially registered as a gelding prior to competition, \$3,000 will be up for grabs at each of this year's 14 approved APHA shows; 11 zone shows and 3 international shows. Awarded to the most outstanding gelding or geldings, through APHA's performance show high-point calculation system, this program provides the owners of these horses an opportunity to compete for bonus incentives nationwide.

Horses are eligible for the incentive money in the zone in which their owner resides. The registered owner(s) of the horse must be a current member of APHA, in good standing. In order to benefit a great number of APHA geldings the incentive money will be awarded to the same gelding only once in a three year period (example: a horse awarded Gelding Plus money and title in 2007 will not be eligible again until 2010, regardless of division.)

Horses can only be awarded the Gelding Plus title and cash in one division. Should a horse win more than one division, the horse will be awarded the title in the division where he has earned the most points.

Already three PHAA members have been recipients of over \$7000 AUD in prizemoney in the last 2 National Shows. 2007 saw Bridget Connelly of Queensland win \$2500-US with her gelding Blaze of Thunder and Jill Wagner of NSW won \$500 with her Paint Bred gelding Royal Heart Throb, at the last National Show Suzanne Bone and Dee Bar Blue The Loot won the \$2500.

So hurry and get your gelding registered with APHA. Go to www.apha.com, then to Forms and Downloads until you find the Registration forms, you will probably need the International Appendix Registration form. It is quite simple to complete, you will need a photocopy of your PHAA registration certificate, the APHA application form and the fees.

- \$500 Solid Paint Bred Show High Point Performance Gelding Highest point total in the following Solid Paint Bred Divisions: Open, Amateur, Youth combined

Gelding Plus FAQ

Do geldings need to be registered as a gelding prior to their 3 year old year to be eligible?

Starting in 2007, as long as the horse is a registered gelding 4 years or older on file with APHA prior to competition, he is eligible to participate in the current Gelding Plus program.

Does my gelding need to have the Gelding Plus emblem on his certificate to participate?

No, as long as your horse is a gelding 4 years or older on file with APHA, he is eligible to participate.

If I would like the Gelding Plus emblem on my horse's certificate, what would be the necessary steps?

We would be happy to provide you with a new certificate that includes the emblem. Please send in the original certificate and a completed Affidavit for Corrected Certificate along with the \$20 fee. The emblem will be added and the corrected certificate will be sent to you shortly.

If my gelding is 3 years or younger how will I know when he is eligible to participate in the Gelding Plus program?

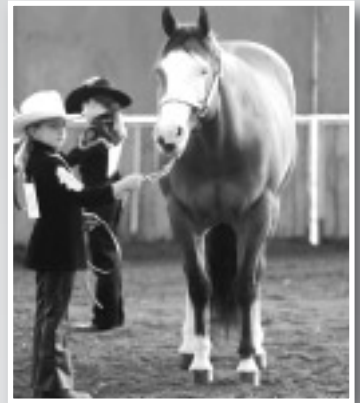
All horses are eligible for the Gelding Plus program at the time

of gelding and are able to participate their 4 year old year. As a reminder we will print the date of eligibility on all gelding registration certificates under the Remarks section.

If my horse is a gelding, but listed as a stallion with APHA, how do I get that changed?

To report that a horse has been gelded, send the original certificate of registration along with a signed statement including the horse's name, registration number, and the date of gelding.

If you do not know the exact date of gelding you may use your date of sale. There is no charge to update the horse's papers. Your gelding is eligible to participate in Gelding Plus if he is 4 years of age or older, and the Gelding Plus logo will appear on the corrected certificate regardless of age. At time of printing, if your horse is 3 years or younger, his participation eligibility date will be printed under the remarks section of the corrected certificate.

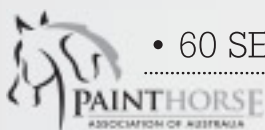

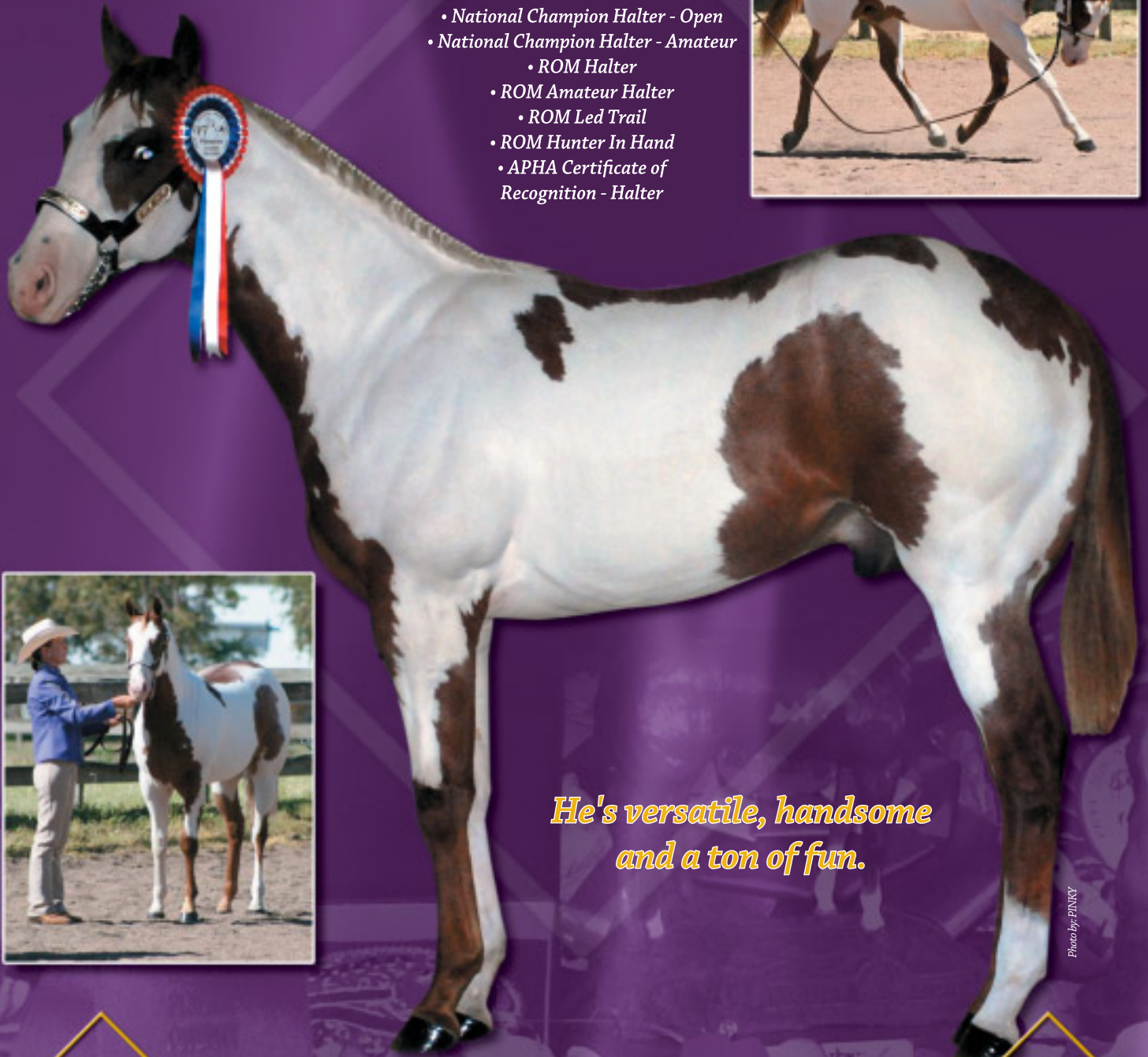

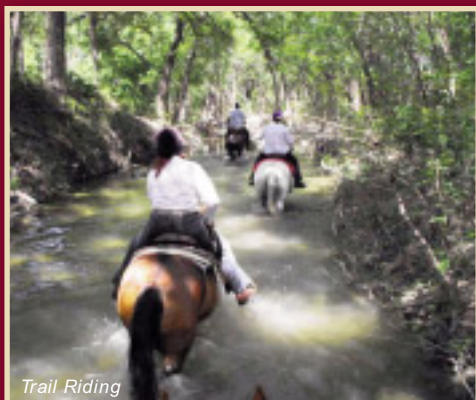

We left off last issue as we headed out to do some more shopping but I wont go into the details of that as we will never get to the World Show so we will pick up with a must see event.....

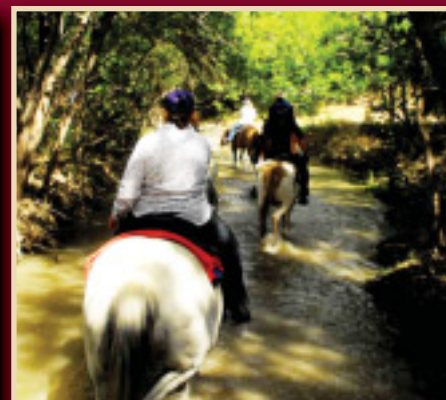

2010 NATIONAL SHOW POLL RESULTS

Following the 2008 National Show and comments and complaints from members, at the last Board of Director's meeting the possibility of moving the National Show to the new Australian Equestrian and Livestock Centre in Tamworth in 2010 was discussed.

THIS venue is proving to be very popular, due in no small part because it is a state of the art, purpose built venue. The Board felt that our premier event of the year deserves the best possible venue, without the issues of trains shunting past the arena at a crucial moment or some of the other safety issues we have faced in the last few years, like leading weanlings past the trotting track at night while the trots are in progress.

Before a major decision such as this is made it was decided to run a poll of members, both through our website and through the Journal to gauge members' thoughts on such a move. The plan was that once we have members reaction we can proceed in gathering more information to give to members or not, depending on the outcome of the poll.

There has been some concern expressed from members that this move is definite. This is not the case. Both on the website and in the Journal the words "possible" and "considering" were used. The Board recognises that our members are intelligent and will consider the issues before responding, and appreciate that we will not make such a decision without consultation.

As you can see the poll resulted in close to 80% of members who voted giving a heads up to a move to Tamworth. At the moment we are aware of some cost differences between Tamworth and Dubbo. Before the next Board meeting some of the Board will be visiting the site to get a first hand view of the venue and facilities and to further investigate costs.

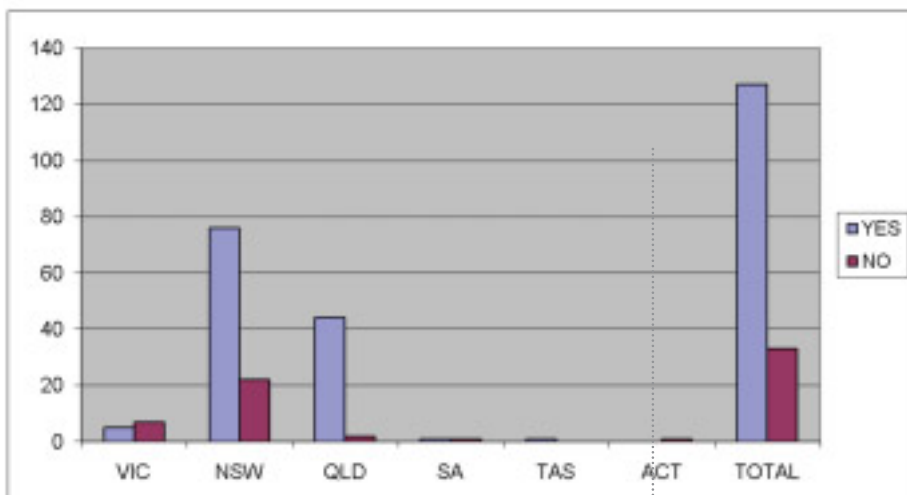

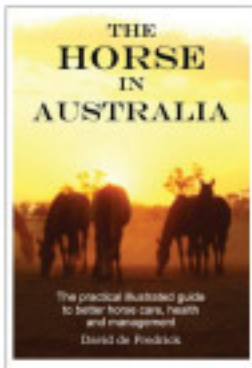

Explaining Show Champion Awards...

At any show Champion, Reserve Champion, Grand Champion or Supreme Champion awards can be given for various disciplines. There is no such thing as 'Reserve Grand Champion' or 'Reserve Supreme Champion'.

.....

- **'Champion' and 'Reserve Champion' Awards:** At standard club, mixed breed or other non-championship shows, the winners of like classes can compete for 'Champion' of that discipline.

For example, the winners of each of the different female breed halter classes (weanling filly, yearling filly, through to senior mare) compete for overall **Champion** breed female.

When the Champion has been selected by the judge, he or she then judges the other class winners **AND the 2nd place getter to the Champion**, to select **Reserve Champion**. That is why second place getters are asked to stand by for judging of Champion. If they were second in their class to the Champion they can be judged for Reserve.

.....

- **'Grand Champion' Awards:** At all National or State 'Championship' Shows, the winners and second place getters of each class are automatically National or State 'Champion' and 'Reserve Champion'. From these 'Champions', a 'Grand Champion' can be selected. There is no 'Reserve Grand Champion' as once you are a Champion of any sort you cannot be downgraded to Reserve. Only Champions (class winners) will compete for Grand Champion.
-

- **'Supreme Champion' Awards:** Supreme Champions are judged from Champions at standard shows or Grand Champions at National or State Championship Shows. Supreme Champions may be awarded at any show but once again there is no Reserve Supreme Champion. Usually the 'Supreme' will be from a specific discipline but include different genders and ages.
-

- **'Supreme Exhibit':** Sometimes shows will have an award for Supreme Exhibit. This will usually cover the Champions of different breeds, genders or even disciplines. It is often awarded at major shows, particularly Royal Shows.

FOAL CLASSIFICATION READY RECKONER...

The Paint Horse has three classifications of horse registration and it is sometimes confusing as to what can produce what. Here is a summary of the various rules covering registration of Australian Paint Horses.

It includes a rule change regarding overo positive solid horses. Effectively, for foal registration purposes only, an OLWS positive solid parent has the same status as a regular registered parent. This is to assist breeders in avoiding overo to overo matings.

NEWS FROM 'Health Care and problems of Horses'

Girth Itches In Horses

Young horses in work occasionally develop a weeping or crusty rash-like condition under the girth, particularly in the area behind the elbow. It is most common during wet, humid conditions, or where the skin is softened or abraded by an ill-fitting girth.

- Symptoms of girth itches
- Treatment of girth itches
- Management of an outbreak
 - Related Products

• **Symptoms of girth itches:**

- Inflamed, sore and 'scurfy' skin
- Bald areas in severe, long-standing cases
- Infection can also spread to include the area under the saddle
- Bacterial infections show swelling, pain and small 'pus' sores Fungal infections show swelling, pain, patchy hair loss (if dry, has a similar appearance to ringworm)
- Horse resists being girthed up and, in severe cases, may be too sore to be ridden
- Can spread from horse to horse on girths, saddlecloths and grooming equipment.
- Most prevalent in young horses, as they often have lower skin immunity against infections, or where the skin is repeatedly softened by moisture (sweating, swimming or hosing without scarping or drying off).

• **Treatment of girth itches:**

Management depends on the severity of the condition. Where the skin is broken or inflamed, or the horse resists being girthed up, avoid saddling by leading the horse out on a rein, or lunging it for exercise.

In severe cases, the treatment will depend on the underlying cause e.g. antibiotics for bacteria, antifungal agents for ringworm-like lesions. Topical treatment alone may not be adequate to clear up the condition, so it is best to seek advice from your vet.

Where there is a mildly sensitive or dry rash appearance, wash the affected area with a medicated wash. Rinse off, and dry thoroughly with a clean towel (allocate one to each horse). Then apply a drying agent to the area twice daily e.g. Cetrigen Spray or Sea Minerals Dermal Spray. Consult your vet if the condition fails to clear in 4 – 7 days.

• **Management of an outbreak:**

Use separate girths and saddlecloths for each horse when an outbreak occurs in a stable. Wash saddlecloths and girths in a disinfectant solution and dry thoroughly after each use.

Dry the girth area thoroughly after work. Avoid using foam rubber padding, which causes excessive sweating and can harbour infection.

In severe outbreaks, cover the girth strap with a sleeve of thin plastic sheeting. Wash outer surface of the sleeve in warm soapy water, rinse well and hang up to dry daily. Allocate a separate plastic sleeve to each horse.

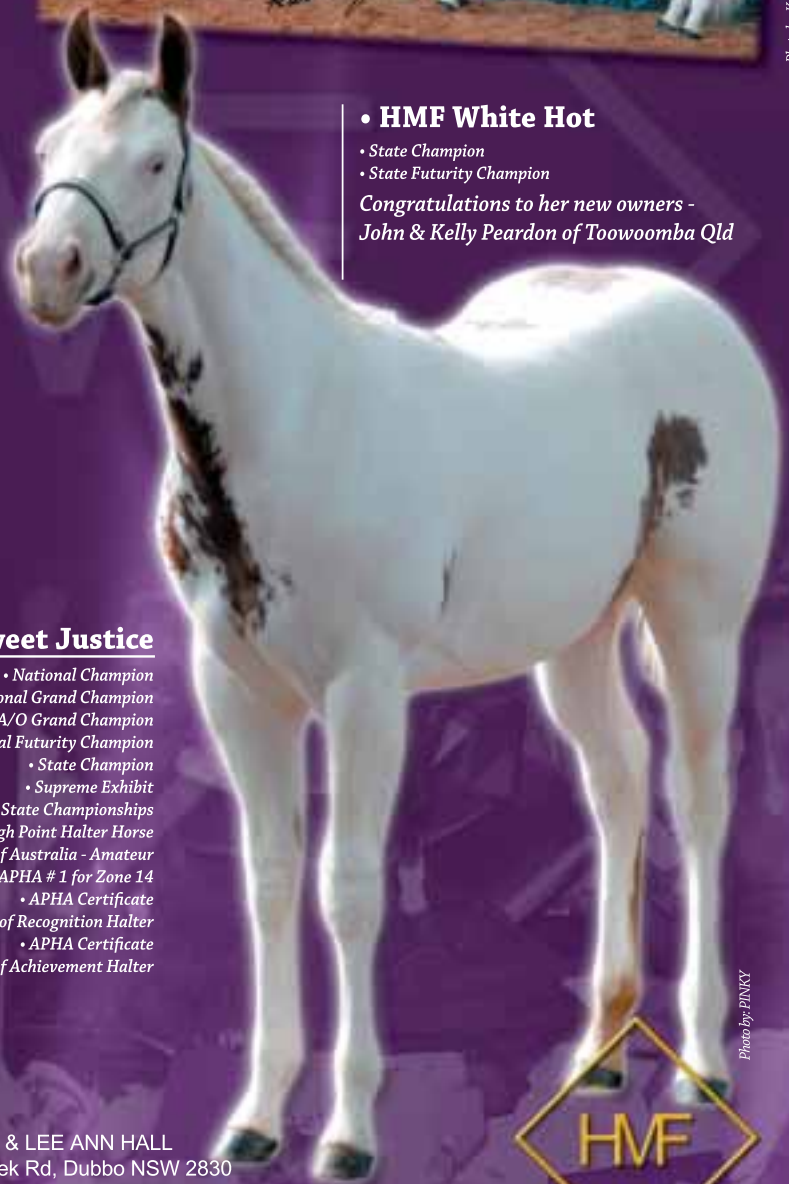
